- Court Orders (if applicable)

Ensuring children get protected from life-threatening meningococcal infection:

On 23 January 2018, WA Health introduced a program to provide free meningococcal ACWY (MenACWY) catch-up vaccine for all children aged 12 months to less than 5 years. This program was introduced because of the rising number of meningococcal infections in WA. Parents of age eligible children should not delay because the WA catch-up vaccination program is time limited and will end on 31 December 2018. Never Stop Reading!

The Department of Education is delighted to introduce **Never Stop Reading!**, an initiative encouraging parents of children from Years 3 to 6 to continue reading aloud with their children as they progress through primary school. Research by Curtin University found that there are significant positive effects of read aloud interventions on children's learning outcomes and social and emotional development. The research found that children continue to enjoy being read to beyond their early years and most was disappointed when their parents stopped. Students in Years 3 to 6 have received a free book mark to use whilst reading.
